**Open-care**  
Superior performance as an infant warmer enables better medical treatment.

**Transport**  
The same environment in the NICU can be provided even during transportation.

**Closed-care**  
The Dual Incu i reduces the infant's stress and supports daily care giving.

**Power pack i (option)**  
Power pack i can maintain appropriate temperature and humidity during transportation, unexpected power failure or power problems.

The Dual Incu I is the first incubator of its kind to have a built-in battery to support all of the equipment needed to safely stabilize and transport a newborn who has special needs. This is not equipment that can be considered a luxury, but rather essential for best practice as we strive to be the regional provider of excellent perinatal and newborn care.
